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Arapahoe County seeks comments on revised Comprehensive Plan for the Lowry Range

Littleton, Colo – The Arapahoe County Planning Commission is hosting a Dec. 19 public hearing to update the Comprehensive Plan. The County will discuss adopting the Sub Area Land Use Plan for the Lowry Range. Citizens are invited to attend the meeting, which will be held at 6:30 p.m. at the County Public Works and Development building, 10730 E. Briarwood Ave., Centennial.

The Sub Area Plan will be used to guide future development on the Lowry Range. The Lowry Range is owned by the State Land Board, which is currently interviewing land developers to choose a development partner or partners for future development of the Range. The Lowry Range encompasses approximately 40 square miles and is located east of E-470 at the Monihan Mile Road extension, north of County Line Road, west of Manilla Road and south of east Yare Avenue.

The draft plan envisions urban type development on 2,880 acres north of east Quincy Avenue and conservation of 22,000 acres south of east Quincy Avenue. The planning process has included input from the many stakeholders and service providers to help develop the plan vision.
