**Arapahoe County Open Burning Ban Suspended**

On June 9, 2006, in consideration of the potential for extreme fire danger in Arapahoe County, Sheriff Grayson Robinson issued an Open Burning Ban for Arapahoe County. Recent rains and cooler temperatures have caused the fire danger in Arapahoe County to be significantly modified.

**The OPEN BURNING BAN**  
**for Arapahoe County is SUSPENDED**

The Sheriff's Office and local fire departments will continue to closely monitor the potential for fire danger in Arapahoe County. Although the potential danger for fire has been reduced, the people of Arapahoe County must continue to exercise reasonable safety precautions, as well as extreme caution when involved with open burning or with any fire.

The decision to suspend the Arapahoe County Open Burning Ban was made after the Sheriff, local fire departments and the Board of County Commissioners evaluated changes to the current conditions related to the potential for fire danger.
