### **SHERIFF'S OFFICE CHARGES DAYCARE WORKER WITH CHILD NEGLECT**

On March 8, 2006 at about 6:58 PM Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to a daycare center identified as:

**Jack & Jill Learning Center  
2035 South Dayton Street  
Denver, CO 80231**

Deputies answered a call that a young female child, aged 17 months, may be locked inside the daycare center. The deputies were met by the father of the child. The father said that he arrived at about 6:25 PM to pick up his daughter and found the daycare closed and no one appeared to be around. The father drove home and contacted his wife, who said she did not pick their daughter up.

Deputies looked through a window at the back of the building and observed the girl asleep in a crib. Responsible people for the daycare were contacted and responded to the daycare and opened it up. The child was returned safe and unharmed to her parents.

Further investigation revealed that an employee of the daycare center did not do a thorough check of the area prior to closing for the day. A summons and complaint was issued to:

The charge on the summons is CRS 18-6-401 (1) (7) (II), a Class 3 misdemeanor. A Class Three Misdemeanor is punishable by six months in the county jail and/or a \$750.00 fine.
