Pothole repair? Traffic signal out?

In Arapahoe County, *One Call, That's All* – 720-874-ROAD – will help fix it

If you live in unincorporated Arapahoe County and see a traffic light that is out, or a pothole that needs repaired, *One Call, That's All* is just the ticket you need.

Arapahoe County Public Works and Development has launched One Call, That's All to help respond to routine and emergency maintenance requests and needs. Unincorporated County residents can call 720-874-ROAD for pothole repairs, street sweeping, sign maintenance requests, snow removal questions, traffic signal outages and reporting of spills or improper waste dumping, to name a few.

One Call, That's All is designed to make it easier for citizens to report emergency and maintenance requests, which in turn allows the County to respond more quickly and efficiently by better tracking maintenance requests.

“Our main focus is to help our citizens, while also letting them know what Arapahoe County Public Works can do to assist the community,” said Dave Schmit, Director of Public Works and Development. “Citizens can give us detailed information on the needs of their neighborhood, and in return we can assess the problem and determine a timely solution.”

To educate residents about One Call, That's All, post cards with a 720-874-ROAD magnet are being mailed to targeted areas of unincorporated Arapahoe County in June. The postcards and magnets also are available at all County offices.
