Early Voting in Arapahoe County is underway at four locations

Arapahoe County's Primary Election is Aug. 10, but voters don't have to wait until Tuesday to vote. Early Voting is underway and will be offered through Friday, Aug. 6 at the following locations:

Hours: 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Wednesday – Friday

Hours: 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Wednesday – Friday

Absentee ballots may be requested in person at the Clerk and Recorder's Office through Friday. The Clerk and Recorder's Office must receive voted ballots by 7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 10 in order to be counted. Postmarks do not count as a receipt. It's recommended that absentee ballots be dropped off at any Clerk and Recorder's Office or any authorized locations now through Tuesday.

Polls will be open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Aug. 10, Election Day.

New this year: Voters who vote early or at the polls on Election Day will need a valid identification to vote. Acceptable forms of identification include a valid Colorado driver's license; U.S. passport; identification card issued by the Department of Revenue; U.S. military ID with photograph; employee identification card issued by the federal, state, county, municipality, board, authority, political subdivision; certified copy of a birth certificate; Medicare or Medicaid card; or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other governmental document that shows the name and address of the elector.
