Homicide Suspect In Custody

On November 24, 2004 at about 8:20 P.M., the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Communications Center received a 911 call requesting medical assistance at 1799 South Dayton Street # 127. Sheriff's Deputies arrived on the scene at about 8:23 P.M.

Upon entering the apartment, Sheriff's Deputies discovered a female kneeling beside a male who was lying on the floor of a bedroom within the apartment. The male appeared to have suffered a gunshot wound to the chest. The male victim, identified as:

Quentin Eugene Johnson

Age 25

was transported to Aurora South Medical Center. Mr. Johnson died as the result of the gunshot to the chest.

After a preliminary investigation, Hurd was taken into custody, without incident. Hurd is being held at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detentions Facility, without bond, pending the filing of formal criminal charges. Hurd will be charged with a violation of:

C.R.S. 18-3-102 Murder In The First Degree, a class one felony.

A class one felony is punishable, upon conviction, by incarceration at the Department of Corrections for life.
