Arapahoe County's General Election is Nov. 2, but voters don't have to wait to vote. Early Voting will be offered from Oct. 18 – 29, 2004 at the following locations:

It's recommended that absentee ballots be dropped off at any Clerk and Recorder's Office or any authorized locations through Election Day, Nov. 2.

New this year: Voters who vote early or at the polls on Election Day will need a valid identification to vote. Acceptable forms of identification include a valid Colorado driver's license; U.S. passport; identification card issued by the Department of Revenue; U.S. military ID with photograph; employee identification card issued by the federal, state, county, municipality, board, authority, political subdivision; certified copy of a birth certificate; Medicare or Medicaid card; or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other governmental document that shows the name and address of the elector.
