## **Free Mammograms and Women's Cancer Screenings**

Tri-County Health Department is offering mammograms, breast exams, Pap tests and pelvic exams free-of-charge to qualifying women. Cancer screening clinics are held in various locations across the metro area, and are scheduled for September 8, 15 and 23; and October 13, 20 and 28.

In order to qualify for these services, a woman must be 40-64 years old; be a Colorado resident; not have health insurance coverage for mammograms or Pap tests; not have had a mammogram or Pap test within the last 12 months; and meet income guidelines.
