ATTEMPTED BANK ROBBERY SUSPECTS IN CUSTODY

On Thursday October 13, 2005 at about 11:27 A.M., an Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office patrol deputy observed an older model Ford Thunderbird turn into the US Bank parking lot located at 6855 South Havana Street. The driver had on a red hooded sweatshirt covering his or her face, so it could not be seen. The deputy, not seeing a license plate on the vehicle became concerned the bank was about to be robbed.

The suspect vehicle drove slowly in front of the bank leaving at a high rate of speed onto East Costilla Avenue. The deputy saw a second person in the vehicle and observed the driver remove the hood from his or her head. The deputy asked for assistance in stopping the vehicle. Other Arapahoe County Sheriff's deputies responded and the vehicle was stopped in the parking lot at 10300 East Arapahoe Road. The two occupants were taken into custody, without incident. The suspects are identified as:

After Macon and Hill were removed from the vehicle, an unloaded .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun was found in the vehicle. Macon and Hill were taken into custody and transported to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detentions Facility. The suspects will be held on a \$50,000 bond for violations of:

C.R.S. 18-2-101 Criminal Attempt Aggravated Robbery, a class four felony.

A class four felony is punishable, upon conviction, by incarceration at the Department of Corrections for two (2) to six (6) years.

C.R.S. 18-2-201 Conspiracy To Commit Aggravated Robbery, a class four felony.

Bond for Macon and Hill are being held at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detentions Facility on a \$50,000 bond.
