Corridor Study Narrows Options for Improving Parker Road Public input needed on suggested improvements

Arapahoe County, CO — The wide range of options identified for improving the Parker Road corridor between Hampden and E-470 have been studied and screened over the past few months, resulting in a set of refined improvement options. The community will have the opportunity to give input on these options at the third public meeting on August 21st at the Shalom Park Retirement Community (14800 E. Belleview Dr.). The meeting will be an open house from 5 to 7:30 p.m., with a brief presentation at 6 p.m.

“Local agencies and the public have helped us identify possible ways to improve the corridor. Now we’ve focused our attention on identifying the most effective improvement options that offer the greatest operational benefits, while minimizing impacts to corridor communities and maintaining realistic implementation costs,” said Bryan Weimer, Transportation Division Manager in Arapahoe County’s Public Works Department.

At the public meeting, a team led by the engineering firm David Evans and Associates, Inc. will display their findings from the Level 2 analysis of improvement options.

“We would like feedback from the public on the viable improvement options for the Parker Road corridor, intersections, parallel and intersecting roads, and public transit and alternative modes of transportation” said Joe Hart, project manager with David Evans and Associates, Inc.

Following the August 21st meeting, the project team will begin packaging the most feasible options into preliminary alternatives for corridor-wide improvement. A fourth public meeting will be held in the coming months to present the refined alternatives, results of the Level 3 screening, and preliminary recommendations.
