Her new single "Comin' Home" written by Dave Adams and produced by Paul McKenna is an anthem for the troops, veterans and their families. The Rick Garcia Band performs a signature blend of Tejano, New Mexico, country, rock and oldies music. The Band is considered one of the finest entertainers in the Denver area and plays Sunday at 3 p.m.
