Arapahoe County to mail Primary Election ballots next week

Voters should expect to receive their ballots in mailboxes July 20-21

Littleton, Colo. --- Arapahoe County voters will soon receive their ballots in the mail for the Aug. 10, 2010 Primary Election.

“Arapahoe County voters registered with the Democratic, Republican or Libertarian parties will be mailed a ballot to participate in the August primary,” said Clerk and Recorder Nancy A. Doty. “Since the Primary Election is a nominating process for the political parties, voters who are registered in one of the three major political parties will be eligible to cast a vote and will receive their ballot beginning July 20.”

Along with their ballot, voters will receive instructions on how to fill out their ballot, as well as options for returning their ballot to the County.

Doty said voters should use a black or blue ball point pen, and should avoid using Sharpie or felt-tip marker pens as they can bleed through the ballot.

Voters also can mail their ballot to the County by placing 61 cents in postage on the envelope, or they can drop their ballot at any of the County’s 14 Mail Ballot Drop-off locations, which includes:

Hours at Mail Ballot Drop-off locations vary. For a complete schedule, visit www.arapahoevotes.com. Voters also can check www.arapahoevotes.com to determine when their ballot was mailed and when Arapahoe County Elections received their ballot.

In addition, Arapahoe County will have Aug. 10, 2010 Primary Election Service Centers available for your convenience beginning Monday, Aug. 2, 2010. At these Service Centers, a voter will be able to register to vote, update their current voter registration, emergency register, request a new ballot, request a replacement ballot and drop off their voted ballot.

An electronic voting machine will be available at each of these locations for voters who wish to use one. This equipment provides audio and visual enhancements for voters with disabilities. The Service Centers are located at the Arapahoe County Administration Building and each of the Motor Vehicle Offices in Arapahoe County.
