Colorado Primary Election is Tuesday, August 10

Voters must affiliate with Republican, Democratic or Libertarian parties to participate

Littleton, Colo.--- Voters wishing to participate in the Aug. 10 Primary, which will be an all-mail ballot election, must be a member of either the Democratic, Republican or Libertarian political parties.

“The Primary Election is a nominating process for the political parties,” said Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder Nancy A. Doty. “Voters must be registered in one of the three major political parties in order to be eligible to cast a vote in the Aug. 10 Primary Election.”

Doty encourages unaffiliated voters, or residents who are not yet registered to vote, to use the State’s new online voter registration system by visiting www.arapahoevotes.com and clicking on the *register to vote* button.

“It’s very easy to change your party affiliation, update your address or even register to vote for the first time,” said Doty, adding that voters also will be able to use the system to request mail ballots for all future Arapahoe County elections.
