**Sheriff Robinson Reappointed
To Statewide Justice Assistance Grants Board**

Governor Bill Ritter has reappointed Arapahoe County Sheriff Grayson Robinson to the statewide Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Board. Sheriff Robinson has proudly served on the Colorado JAG Board since April 2003.

Members of the JAG Board are appointed by the governor and are responsible to:

1. Advise the Division of Criminal Justice on issues related to federal block grant monies designated to improve the criminal justice system, reduce drug abuse, reduce drug related crimes and reduce violent crimes.
2. Review the State plan for authorized JAG program funding.
3. Review grant applications from state and local agencies and recommend funding allocations.
