## *Holiday Safety Tips (Part II)*



The holiday season can be one of the highest crime times of the year, please take the following precautions to ensure the safety of you and your family:

### **At Home**

- Keep gifts hidden from view through outside windows.
- After opening gifts, break down cardboard boxes of expensive electronics and fancy stores and put them in plastic bags before putting them out with the trash. Hide the fact you have valuable items in your home.
- Be extra cautious about locking doors and windows when you leave your house or apartment, even for a few minutes.
- Be wary of solicitations for charitable donations. They may attempt to take advantage of people's generosity during the holidays. Ask for identification, how donated funds are used, if contributions are tax deductible. If you are suspicious about their behavior, contact the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office.
