L. NARRATIVE	<p>On February 5, 2009, at approximately 9:15 PM, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to the 1900 block of South Quebec Way on the report of a robbery that had just occurred. The victim, a Pizza Hut delivery driver, told the deputies that two black males approached him and took the food and his money after displaying a gun. The suspects were last seen walking south on Quebec Way.</p> <p>The suspects were described as being in their late teens or early 20's. The suspect that had displayed the gun was 5' 08" tall and was wearing a grey sweatshirt and red baseball cap. The second suspect was 6'02" tall and was wearing a dark grey or black hoodie and black baseball cap.</p> <p>When ACSO Deputy McCauley arrived in the area he observed two black males, matching the description given by the victim, leaving the complex in a red Pontiac Grand Prix. Deputy McCauley stopped the vehicle in the 8500 block of East Evans Avenue. Upon contact the deputy observed a pizza box on the back seat along with a grey sweatshirt and red baseball cap. A Pizza Hut bag and money were also observed on the front passenger floorboard. After removing both suspects from the vehicle, a black replica semi-automatic pellet gun was found in the driver's door compartment. The two suspects (one adult and one juvenile) were taken into custody.</p> <p>The adult suspect was identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SHACKLEFORD, STANLEY, Age 19 (Photo not to be released)</p> <p>Shackleford was transported to the Arapahoe County Detention Facility and charged with: Aggravated Robbery, Felony Menacing and Theft. Bond \$50,000.</p> <p>The Juvenile suspect was transported to the Arapahoe County Juvenile Assessment Center and charged with: Aggravated Robbery, Felony Menacing and Theft.
