<p>On January 14, 2009, at approximately 2:19 p.m., Deputies from the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office responded to the 6700 block of South Cherry Street on the report of a dog bite. Upon arrival they contacted the reporting party who was identified as a 57 year old female homeowner.</p> <p>The homeowner stated that she has been dog sitting her brother's pit-bull while he is out of town. Her minor granddaughter was in a bedroom with the pit-bull when she screamed. The reporting party went into the bedroom where she found the child on the floor. When she attempted to pick up her granddaughter, the dog attacked her.
