Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Investigating Homicide

On November 6, 2009, at 5:30 am, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Deputies and South Metro Fire Rescue responded to a report of a person who was lying face down on a residential lawn in the 8700 block of East Philips Place. When the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office deputies arrived on the scene, they found a young adult male, lying face down, with no visible trauma injuries. The victim, Andrew Graham, age 23, was checked by rescue personnel at the scene and was determined to be deceased. The death of Mr. Graham has been determined to be a homicide.

During the homicide investigation, the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office obtained a copy of RTD Light Rail surveillance video showing Mr. Graham, along with six other persons, riding in a Light Rail car on Thursday, November 5th at 11:40 P.M. Anyone with any knowledge of the identities of the persons on the video is asked to contact the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office immediately at 303-795-4711.

The Sheriff's Office does not believe that any of the other six individuals pictured in the video are involved in the homicide of the victim; they are simply the last people we know of who saw Mr. Graham in life. The Sheriff's Office investigators would like to talk with these six individuals, ask them if there were any events that occurred on the train, and if they noticed any activity that evening at the County Line Light Rail Platform.

Anyone with any information related to a suspect for this murder is asked to contact the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office immediately at 303-795-4711. A significant cash reward may be available for viable information.
