Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputy Receives Top Honors at Annual Mothers Against Drunk Driving Recognition Event

On September 19, 2009, at the 2009 Colorado Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) Law Enforcement Recognition Event, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Deputy Jay Zachman was awarded the "Outstanding Individual Dedication to Minors in Possession Enforcement Award."

The MADD Law Enforcement Recognition Event is held annually to recognize outstanding efforts by deputy sheriffs, state troopers and police officers from across Colorado. Individuals are recognized for their dedication to MADD's mission to "stop drunk driving, support the victims of violent crime and to prevent underage drinking."

Deputy Zachman was recognized for his commitment to enforcing Colorado's underage alcohol laws has made an impact on underage drinking in our community which results in a safer environment for our youths to live and grow. Zachman issued 56 citations for minors in possession (MIP) of alcohol in 2008, which was the highest number of MIP citations issued by Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies.
