Sheriff to Implement New Biometric Technology System to Protect Children and Seniors

Arapahoe County Sheriff Grayson Robinson, Peter Flynn, Retired Sheriff of Plymouth County, Massachusetts and co-founder of The Child Project™, and Patricia Lawton, Senior Development Officer of BI2 Technologies & The Child Project™ will host a press conference and demonstration on:

The biometric technology is being provided through a National Sheriffs' Association grant. The grant, the first to be awarded in Colorado, provides at no cost to the taxpayers of Arapahoe County an iris biometric system that is part of a nationwide network and registry.

The innovative system which will be demonstrated at the February 5th press conference uses iris recognition biometric technology to confirm a person's identity. The grant includes The Child Project™, Senior Safety Net™, Inmate Recognition and Identification System (I.R.I.S.™) and Sex Offender Registry and Identification System (SORIS™) systems. The Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office will use the technology to enroll and compare the unique features contained in the human iris against a database of individuals who have been previously enrolled throughout the country to positively determine identity in seconds.
