		<p>On June 3, 2010 at about 4:03 A.M., the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office received several reports of a possible Black Bear in the area of the 6300 block of South Buckley Road. The bear was reported to be eastbound on Caley Avenue from Buckley Road. Deputies responded to the area but were unable to locate any sign of the bear.</p> <p>On June 4, 2010 at about 6:24 A.M., the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office received ten separate reports of a possible bear in the 5200 block of South Hannibal Way. As deputies began checking the area, the Sheriff's Office received additional reports the bear was sighted in the areas of 15400 block of East Progress Circle and the 5700 block of South Jasper Way. Deputies were unable to locate the bear.</p> <p>On June 5, 2010 at about 9:26 A.M., the Sheriff's Office received a single report of the bear in the greenbelt near the 5900 block of South Mobile Street. The area was searched by several deputies, to include a motorcycle deputy to check the bike paths on either side of the Piney Creek between Tower Road and Parker Road. There was no sign of the bear. The bear has been identified as weighing about 150 pounds.</p> <p>Citizens living in the area of bear sightings should consider the following reminders and precautions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wildlife / human encounters can occur anywhere in Colorado - Be aware of your surroundings and watch for possible bear activity, such as disturbed trash cans - Don't leave pets out at night or unattended in yards for long periods of time - Bears are naturally timid and will most likely flee from pet or human contact - Remove and secure bird feeders during night-time hours - Additional bear sightings should be reported to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office at 303.795.4711 - For more information regarding bears in urban areas, please visit the Department of Wildlife website at www.wildlife.state.co.us/bears. <p>For additional information contact Sheriff Grayson Robinson at 303.880.2201.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">E N D</p>
