NARRATIVE</p> <p>On January 26, 2008, at approximately 2:25 PM, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area of the 17600 block of East Progress Circle regarding a report of a dangerous dog that had bitten two people. Upon arrival the dog, a black lab mix, charged, but did not bite, the deputy. The dog was eventually cornered in its back yard. As an Animal Control Officer attempted to control the animal with a loop, the dog charged another deputy who used a Taser to incapacitate the animal.</p> <p>The dog bite victims were identified as a 50 year old male and a 12 year old female.</p> <p>The male victim had been jogging in the area and was bitten on his right leg. The twelve year old victim was bitten on the right leg as she walked down the sidewalk. The female victim was transported to a local hospital, where she was treated and released.</p> <p>Animal Control Officers left a note for the owner at the residence and transported the dog to a shelter.</p> <p>For further information, please contact Sheriff Grayson Robinson at 720-874-4165.</p>
