NARRATIVE	<p>At about 6:49 pm, on April 2, 2008, the IMPACT Unit was working a special assignment called the "Shoulder Tap" Enforcement Program, which is aimed at reducing third party transactions of alcoholic beverages to individuals under twenty-one years of age. While conducting surveillance at the Saddle Rock Liquors, an underage subject was observed walking into the establishment and exiting with a bottle containing a suspected alcoholic beverage concealed beneath his jacket. The subject walked across the parking lot to a 1996 Saturn, which was subsequently stopped for a minor traffic violation. The subject seen exiting the establishment was identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Roe, Joel Age: 19</p> <p>Mr. Roe stated he purchased a bottle of Captain Morgan's Rum from a clerk at the liquor store without showing identification, but had represented himself as being 21 years old. Contact was made with the store clerk:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Zewdie, Woinitu Age: 27</p> <p>Ms. Zewdie admitted selling the liquor to Mr. Roe without checking his identification.</p> <p>Mr. Roe was issued a summons for: C.R.S. 18-13-122 Illegal Possession of Ethyl Alcohol by an Underage Person C.R.S. 12-47-901 Obtaining an Alcoholic Beverage by Misrepresentation When Under 21 Years of Age.</p> <p>Ms. Zewdie was issued a summons for: C.R.S. 12-47-901 (1) (a5) Selling an Alcoholic Beverage to an Underage Person.</p> <p>Both subjects were released at the scene.</p> <p>For further information, please contact Sheriff Grayson Robinson at (720) 874-4165.</p>
