L. NARRATIVE	<p>On February 27, 2008, at approximately 7:30 a.m., deputies responded to the 5200 block of South Shawnee Street on a reported indecent exposure. Upon arrival, deputies met with the reporting party who told deputies that he had seen a man running up and down the street completely naked. Deputies made contact with the subject, who was identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Kevin Lininger – Age 28</p> <p>Lininger was arrested for Indecent Exposure and transported to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detention Facility. Once in the Booking Area, he began urinating on the floor, became belligerent, and began kicking his urine in the direction of deputies.
