NARRATIVE	<p>On March 26, 2008, at approximately 7:21 pm, The IMPACT Unit was working a special assignment called the "Shoulder Tap" Enforcement Program in order to reduce third party transactions of alcoholic beverages to those individuals under twenty-one years of age. While conducting surveillance at the International Wine and Spirits store location, a subject was observed walking into the establishment and exiting with a bag containing suspected alcohol. The subject walked across the parking lot to the Taco Bell restaurant and met with another subject at the side of the building in the bushes. Both subjects were later identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Forbush, Benjamin Age: 31 Muth, Nicholas Age: 20</p> <p>Mr. Forbush was seen lighting a suspected marijuana pipe and smoking from it while Mr. Muth was seen drinking from a bottle of suspected alcohol. Both subjects were contacted and it was learned that Mr. Forbush purchased a bottle of Fat Tire beer from the liquor store and gave it to Mr. Muth. When Mr. Muth was contacted, he was found to be in possession of the alcohol, as well as a small amount of suspected marijuana and a suspected marijuana pipe with residue.</p> <p>Mr. Forebush was issued a summons and released at the scene.
