L. NARRATIVE	<p>On May 13, 2008, at approximately 8:00 PM, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the 18000 block of East Berry Drive on the report of subjects lighting fires near the playground in the park. Upon arrival, the Deputies canvassed the area finding two small gasoline cans and a skateboard. Minor damage had occurred to the playground's plastic slide equipment from gasoline being poured on it and lit.</p> <p>Deputies later identified a juvenile suspect after a sibling was sent to the park to retrieve the skateboard. During a non custodial interview with the juvenile subject's mother present, the subject stated that he and a friend were bored so they attempted to set the skateboard on fire using gas cans found in the family's garage. They walked to the park where they poured gasoline on pinecones, twigs and the playground slide. They left after several neighbors came out of their homes and yelled at them.</p> <p>The second juvenile subject was contacted and also agreed to a non custodial interview with both parents present. Statements made by the first subject in the earlier interview were confirmed by the second subject.</p> <p>Both juveniles were released to their parents pending charges for 18-4-103 Second Degree Arson.</p> <p>For further information please contact Sheriff J.
