	<p>K. On Thursday, January 10, 2008, at about 10:19 P.M., the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office responded to the 19200 block of East Lake Drive on a robbery that had just occurred. The Reporting Party stated that he had just returned from Denver International Airport and made several stops before going home. As he was driving through his neighborhood he noticed a vehicle was following him. He pulled into his garage, got out and walked to the mailbox, and then returned to the garage.</p> <p>He was confronted by a white male wearing a hoodie and blue jeans. The victim was attacked by that male and another suspect, and while he was fighting with them, he heard one of the suspects say, "Let's just kill him." In an attempt to avoid being killed, the victim pulled out his wallet and gave it to the suspects. After handing over his wallet, the victim grabbed a pick-axe and attempted to hit the suspects. Both suspects fled the garage and ran to an older black or blue colored vehicle that was parked just north of the residence. An Aurora Police Department K-9 Unit responded to assist and checked the area.
