L. NARRATIVE	<p>On January 9, 2008, at approximately 8:57 pm, Arapahoe County Sheriffs Office Deputies were called to the 5900 Block of South Platte Canyon Road on a reported suspicious noises incident. The Deputy arrived on scene and was checking the area when he heard shots fired. He could see muzzle flashes coming from the front porch of a house located directly north of his location.</p> <p>With the assistance of Columbine Valley and the Littleton Police Department a perimeter was quickly established. Once officers were in position, an Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Dispatcher made a call to the house. She told the occupants that the house was surrounded and to exit the front door with their hands up. The individual on the phone told her he knew why the officers were there and that he fired the gun. An arrest team was established and the four individuals in the house were detained without incident. The Canine Unit cleared the house and no other occupants were located. The individual who admitted to firing the gun was identified as;</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Johnson, Justin – Age 30</p> <p>Johnson, who was intoxicated, said he was shooting at some cans and a hay bale in the front yard. He was taken to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detention Center and charged with CRS 18-3-208 Reckless Endangerment 3M and 18-12-106 Prohibited Use of a Weapon 2M.
