On June 15, 2008, at approximately 9:30 A.M., Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Littleton Adventist Hospital on a report of a 31 year old female patient in the Emergency Room that had been stabbed. Upon arrival, deputies contacted the victim who told deputies that she and her two roommates were at home on East Orchard Road using methamphetamines. An argument ensued and the suspect identified as:

MARQUEZ, DORA (No Photograph to be Released)
AGE 31

brandished a kitchen knife and told the other resident, identified as a 49 year old male that she was going to kill him. The 31 year old female victim attempted to step between Dora Marquez (no relation) and the 49 year old male victim. The female victim had multiple stab wounds none of which were life threatening, and she stated that the male roommate had sustained a single stab wound. Deputies immediately responded to the Orchard Road address to do a welfare check on the male roommate. Once on scene, they contacted the 49 year old male victim, who did in fact have a stab wound. The male victim was transported to Littleton Adventist Hospital by Littleton Fire/Rescue where he was treated for his non-life threatening injuries.

The suspect Dora Marquez, had fled the scene.

On Sunday, June 15, 2008, at about 11:50 P.M., Sergeant Peterson was conducting an increase patrol in the area of the 200 block of East Orchard Road when he noticed a vehicle and two people outside of the residence. Deputy Kyelberg responded and the house was placed under surveillance. Shortly afterwards the vehicle left the residence and proceeded to go northbound on South Broadway. At about 11:59 P.M., Sergeant Peterson, Deputy Kyelberg, and Lieutenant Holstein initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the 5700 block of South Broadway. The driver was an elderly male and the passenger was a white female with short bleach blonde hair that appeared to be in her early thirties.

The female stated she was Dora Marquez's sister; however, after further questioning, the female confessed that she was Dora Marquez, and was taken into custody.

A Smith & Wesson model 10 - .38 caliber revolver and a Daisy BB gun that looked like a .45 caliber semi-automatic pistol were found in the center console of the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle said that Dora Marquez must have put the guns in the vehicle. Both guns were taken as found property.

The suspect is being held on \$50,000 bond pending the filing of the following criminal charge:

Second degree assault, a Class 4 Felony.

A Class 4 Felony is punishable, upon conviction, by a sentence of two to six years imprisonment within the Department of Corrections.
