	<p>On September 1, 2008, at approximately 3:38 PM, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Deputy, Abbott, was working selective traffic enforcement in the 7600 block of northbound Interstate 25, when a grey Volkswagen bug went past him traveling at approximately 115 miles per hour. Deputy Abbott activated his emergency equipment, advised dispatch and attempted to catch up to the vehicle. When Deputy Abbott realized the driver was not yielding, he turned off his emergency equipment and advised dispatch of the vehicle's last known location. As Deputy Abbott approached 6700 South Interstate 25, several motorists indicated the vehicle had gotten off the highway at the Arapahoe Road exit.</p> <p>Deputy Abbott exited and noticed that the vehicle had struck the center median dividing the northbound on and off ramps. The driver of the vehicle was observed fleeing on foot through the shopping center parking lot in the 6900 block of South Clinton Street where he was taken into custody and identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">NATHAN HURLBIRT, 27 years old</p> <p>As additional deputies arrived on the scene, they were advised that a female passenger had moved the vehicle off the roadway and into the parking lot of the La Quinta Inn at 9009 East Arapahoe Road. The female was identified as:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">KRISTEN BORIE, 26 years old</p> <p>South Metro Fire Department staff responded to the scene. Both occupants of the vehicle were transported to a local area hospital where they were examined and released with no injuries.</p> <p>Nathan Hurlbirt was taken to the Arapahoe County Detention Facility where he was charged with:</p> <p>18-9-116.5 Vehicular Eluding; 42-4-1301 Driving Under the Influence; 42-4-1401 Reckless Driving; and 42-2-138 Driving Under Restraint</p> <p>Hurlbirt's bond was set at \$10,000.</p> <p>For further information please contact Sheriff J.
